Civica's insulin glargine-yfgn is available in pre-filled pens. Civica sells its pens to pharmacies for \$45 for a box of five pre-filled pens and has set a maximum recommended price for consumers of no more than \$55.

The cost to consumers may be even lower than \$55, depending on a person's insurance plan.

- **If you have health insurance**, check your plan's formulary to ensure **Civica insulin glargine-yfgn** is listed. If so, just ask your pharmacy to order it when you take in your prescription.
